AA and A divisions will shoot 13 games and start at 7:30, B on down will shoot 9 games and start at 7:00. Schedules will be emailed out, put at the bars and posted on the website (automaticvendors.net) We will have the usual mailboxes this year; at Longbranch, Lariat, The Office and Bogey's – just give this one to the bartender. And please direct any questions you have for 501 to Alex and Julie, and to Julie for scoresheet issues.

Feats: Please keep track of your feats on the back of your scoresheets if you would like. The dart league may purchase feat pins for you again this year.

New Boards: We have new (to us) boards..finally! We may attempt to put the schedules on them later on. Julie will do the stats this year again, emailing them and posting them on the website. Subs will have their own spreadsheet with their ppd's and phone numbers listed for you.

State 2009-2010: State will be in Rapid this year, February 24-28. You must have 30 games played, in NO LESS than 6 weeks of play, before we send our stuff to the state. So keep this in mind if you have more than 4 players on your roster and plan accordingly. You will have til mid December to accomplish this. This year there is also an option of playing either Cricket OR 501 for doubles play.
