This is a very important email. Print it off or save it somewhere. Share it with all players who may not have email or computer access. I would rather you help me out this way then bombard me with phone calls and emails later on.

Minutes, etc: You will notice that most of the minutes are now on the website. I am working on finishing these up and I am so close! I am still working on the By-Laws and they will be added when I get caught up on the more pertinent information.

Subs: I will be sending out an updated list of the subs who still need to pay the \$7. There are quite a few who still have not paid. We will not accept your rosters for state without the money for your subs so you need to make arrangements to get these paid as soon as possible. And FYI: the sanction fee went up to \$8 this year. The league is covering the extra \$1 for everyone but starting next season our team roster sheets will reflect this change.

Dummy player: If you end up short a player you can still shoot your match. You leave the absent player at 501. Each time you come to their score you pass them, leaving them at 501 for the entire game. The freeze rule STILL APPLIES. This means that you must go out (with your partner at 501) before your opponents have the opportunity to. You will have to throw some monster darts to accomplish this. Obviously your best bet is to make sure you have 4 players present! If you have any questions please contact myself or Jason Masteller.

Tourneys: Look for more information on a couple upcoming tournaments for the PADL. On 12/4 we will be having a benefit tournament for Tony Deters at Bubba Rays. I was also given an absolutely beautiful one of a kind print to help with the cause. We were thinking of possibly doing the Blunt format for this. I am not real sure how that went but I know that you end up playing with everyone or most everyone as partners. This is a great way to get to know more of your dart family! The other will be a tournament sometime in January. We are having trouble finding a venue as it is the holiday season now.

Youth League: The youth league has officially started! Robin Masteller has done an awesome job so far and you can really sense the dedication she has to our kids! She is in dire need of parts and pieces from everyone! Please consider cleaning out your dart cases and donating. A set of flights you never liked, sets of darts, cases, barrels, shafts, out guides, she will take it all! We tell the kids they don't need darts to join but at this point the supply is very bleak. You can bring your kids any time, they don't have to go every week. It only costs \$1 each week plus quarters. Robin has a Christmas party in the works and she welcomes all parent volunteers. State Tournament: I put an address on the website for the start dart tourney: (demusic.net) This is the site where you can print of state rosters, find motels, view times and dates for the tourney, schedules and much more.

Games for state: The last week you can use for games for state is December 14th. You need to MAKE SURE you are looking at all your team players now so they all get the games they need. You have to shoot AT LEAST 6 WEEKS, and in that 6 weeks or more, you have to have AT LEAST 30 games. One new item: the team games DO COUNT towards your total games! This is new this year with using the boards for score keeping.

State tourney sign ups: There will be 2 nights to sign up for state. They are December 7th and December 14th. I will be at the Lariat from 6:00 - 7:00 along with Jason to collect the rosters for single, double and team events. Remember that you will need to turn in money for every sub that is not paid at the time you turn in your money for state.

501 Banquet: The date for our end of year banquet will is February 19th at the Lariat. At this time we are planning a luck of the draw; 2 division tourney. As always we will have food, give awards for each division and hold elections. If you are interested in an office please visit with one of the officers. This will be here before we know it.
